

Canadian Ski Instructors Alliance (CSIA Alberta) L1 Course Application

COURSE DETAILS

Length of Course: 21 hours total including online workshop time and a 3 day course.

Cost of Course: **\$399.00** – plus gst

(Please note the course cost does not include: Lift Tickets, Accommodations, Meals or Transportation.)

ELIGIBILITY

- Strong parallel skier (willing and able to ski a black run if required), **minimum of 15 years of age**, at the time of course.
- Knowledge of CSIA skiing skills will be beneficial although not required. Online material completed is required before the end of the level one course.

COURSE CONTENT

- A 21 hour program designed to better develop skiing, guest experience and teaching abilities of potential ski instructors.
- Teaching strategies will focus on developing skiers from beginner to parallel.
- Candidates will receive feedback on their personal ski performance and ability to demonstrate CSIA Technique.
- This course is a PASS/FAIL evaluation based upon candidates' skiing, and understanding of the guest experience, and teaching concepts presented.
- Candidates must pass guest experience, skiing and teaching components to be certified as CSIA Level 1 Instructors.

POLICY / PROCEDURES

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Courses will be conducted as scheduled.
- In the event a participant for any reason is unable to attend the course, notification must be made to the CSIA (Alta) Level 1 office at 1 888 777-0444 2 weeks prior to the first scheduled day of the course for a full refund. Otherwise a \$100 administration fee will be charged.

REFUNDS

- a \$100 administrative fee will be charged for any refund, cancellation or transfer except for medical reasons (Doctor's certificate required)
- A full refund will only be provided when course organizers cancel a course.
